PRINCE GEORGE AIR IMPROVEMENT ROUNDTABLE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING NOVEMBER 17TH

The Prince George Air Improvement Roundtable Society (PG AIR) will hold its first annual general meeting (AGM) on Tuesday, November 17th.

Formerly known as the Prince George Air Quality Implementation Committee (PGAQIC), PG AIR is a community-based, non-profit society focused on improving air quality in the Prince George airshed. PG AIR is a multi-stakeholder group, with representatives from provincial, municipal and regional governments, Northern Health, industry, business and community groups, the public, and the University of Northern BC. Through consensus-based decision making, PG AIR is responsible for developing the Prince George Air Quality Management Plan (Plan), which sets out recommendations for voluntary actions intended to improve air quality in the Prince George airshed.

The AGM will be held from 6:30 to 7:30PM in the Keith Gordon Room of the Prince George Public Library (Bob Harkins branch, downtown). The agenda will include an overview of the projects carried out under the current Phase II Plan during the last year (2008-09) and the projects planned for the upcoming year (2009-10), an introduction to the new 2009-10 PG AIR executive, and the awarding of the 2008-09 PG AIR volunteer of the year award. Light refreshments will be provided.
