

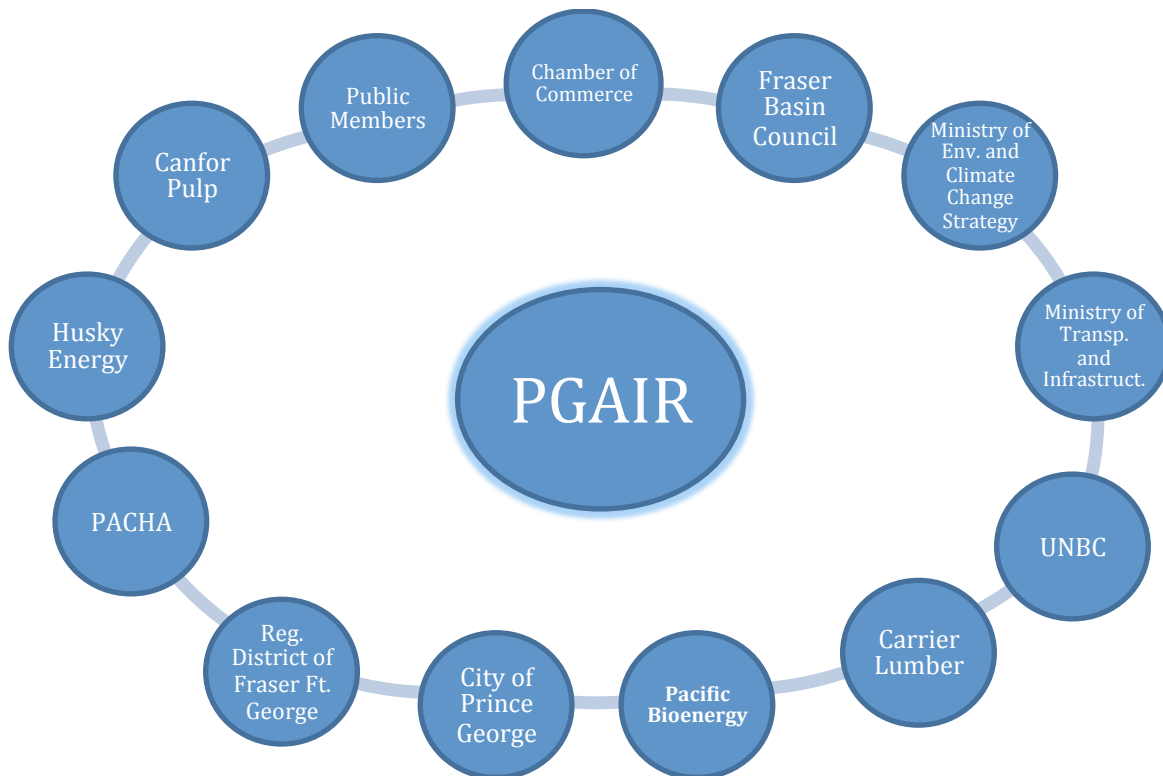


10th Anniversary of the Prince George Air Improvement Roundtable (PGAIR)!
