# 2018 Wood Stove Exchange Program

Rebate Program for Prince George & RDFFG Residents

## How it Works

The first 35 residents of Prince George or the Regional District of Fraser Fort George to trade in their old smoky wood stove for a new emissions certified wood burning appliance will receive a **\$500 rebate** with an additional **\$150 rebate** for trading to a qualifying electric heat, natural gas, propane, or pellet-fuelled appliance. Program participants who require a heating unit permit through their municipal or regional district office will receive an additional **\$130** towards their permit fee.
